Holy Humor Sunday/Monday April 27/28

Many churches are resurrecting an old Easter custom begun by early Greek Christians-

Dear Bethel Members,

The Free Store (TFS) is an interfaith, non-profit organization supporting people in Marquette County who express a need for free clothing, housewares, personal hygiene items and household cleaning supplies. TFS now has over 1,800 registered participants, representing more than 4,000 family members. Many of our shoppers come to us from the Ishpeming area.

Often grant funds help us with the purchase of these supplies; however, the increasing number of registered families often deplete the items we have on hand.
